

BY-LAW BUZZ: Dogs

No person may keep a dog-

1. Which barks, whimpers or howls to the extent that it causes a disturbance;
2. Which suffers from an infectious or contagious disease;
3. On premises not fenced, so that it is at all times confined to the premises.

No person may bring a dog into a public place if-

1. It is wild, dangerous or ferocious;
2. It is in the habit of chasing or charging at people or vehicles;
3. It is an unsterilised female on heat.

In Public Places:

1. Any dog must be kept on a leash and under control;
2. A person in control of a dog must remove any defecation of such dog.

Prohibited Behaviour:

1. No person may, without reasonable grounds, incite a dog against, or attack or put fear into, any person, animal or bird
2. No person may provoke, harass or tease any dog.
3. No person may terrify, or cause stress or fear to any dog with fireworks or by any other means.
